Please note that by submitting an abstract you will be designated the corresponding author for that abstract and all communications regarding the abstract (submission, review, presentation etc.) will be sent to the email address you used to set up your account. There is no restriction to the number of abstracts that can be submitted.

Note:

Once you click '**submit**' your abstract cannot be amended. Abstracts can **ONLY** be amended while they are in '**draft**' version but please make sure you send your abstract by clicking "**submit**" before the deadline of **25th February 2018**.

All abstracts are reviewed by the International Scientific Committee. Authors will be notified by 20th March 2018 on acceptance of their submission.

- J. Resistance against gender equality; implicit bias
- K. Career pathways, and impediments to advancement
- L. LGBTIQ+ and gender/sexual identities
- M. Sexual harassment, gender-based violence and sexist behaviour
- N. Gender implications in research funding
- O. Gender-based research, teaching and learning, including across disciplines
- P. Gender research and integration of findings into higher education, including beyond social science and humanities
- Q. Gender equality and anti-discrimination training for teachers, equality professionals and academic and scientific leaders and managers
